## How will the Pupils be Assessed in GCSE's?

Since September 2009 GCSE'S have been revised to offer schools and their students new enhanced opportunities for teaching and learning. These changes will take place over a number of years.

New GCSE's will have up to 3 ways of assessing your child which will be new to many parents.

These areas are

1. **Controlled assessment** – Controlled assessment has replaced coursework at GCSE level. It is part of the assessment scheme in most, but not all, subjects. Controlled assessment differs from coursework essentially in that the final piece is produced under closely supervised conditions. In some subjects this may mean writing up the final piece in class over the course of one or more lessons monitored by your teacher. Supporting materials such as notes may be used during the writing up, but not a complete draft. Your teachers will give you details on how controlled assessment is carried out in their subjects.
2. **Terminal assessment** – an examination taken at the end of the two year course – maths for example has final exams taken at the end of Year 11
3. **Unitisation** – many of the new GCSE'S are divided into units which are separately assessed. Most GCSE's have 4 units but a double will have 8 units and a short course will have 2 units. Your child may sit exams at various points throughout the two year course – rather than the traditional single exam taken at the end of Year 11.



'Controlled Assessment' is the new term for internal assessment and replaces 'Coursework' and is a national initiative brought in with the new GCSE specifications.

Each stage of the assessment has different levels of control (Informal and Formal supervision) set by exam specifications. These levels are designed to ensure the assessment's authenticity and reliability. Your guidance and help is most welcome, however this may only be allowed during periods of informal or low level supervision. When it is formal or high level control the pupils receive no guidance and work almost in exam conditions.

This is very different to coursework with the majority of work being completed in the classroom rather than at home. The reasons behind the change is to reduce the opportunities for some pupils to copy work off the internet, plagiarise or submit work which is not completely theirs. However it is still an extended response by the pupil to an area of each subjects specification, but there may some restrictions on time and the word count.

Any research sections where pupils collect secondary data must be fully referenced, with pupils stating which website or text was used to gather that information.

Each controlled assessment will provide an opportunity for pupils to achieve marks that will count towards their final grade. For this reason their attendance is a key factor that will assist in their success. Also deadlines must be met or marks will be lost.

Some subjects no longer include this internal assessment which previously might have included examinations and coursework.
